MATERIALS LIST

- [Carnelian Coat](#) digital pattern
- [Carnelian Coat Kit](#) (optional purchase)
 - Or use similar fabric
 - 60" 3½ yards - All Sizes
- 100% cotton thread for sewing woven fabrics
- Isacord thread for overlocking
- Silk thread for marking tailor's tacks and hand sewing needle
- Tracing paper and tracing wheel
- Manilla file folder
- Glasshead silk pins
- Frixion pen
- Chakoner
- 18" C-thru ruler
- Point turner
- Fusi-Web
- Ripper
- Seam gauge
- Finger mitts
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Trimming scissors
- Large cutting shears
- Bias Tape Maker by Clover or equal
- Walking foot or engage even feed feature
- ¼" presser foot
- Tailoring board
- Tailors ham
- Point Presser
- Large Safety Pin or Bodkin

You will need a sewing machine that has been cleaned and oiled and is in good condition. If your machine also embroiders and has a 9mm throat plate, you may want to invest in a 5mm-wide throat plate. If you have the even feed feature on your machine, engage it. If not, add a walking foot, if possible. We recommend a serger for seam finishes.

Purchase the Pattern

Purchase the digital Carnelian Coat pattern. You can now select for us to print the pattern for you from our in-house printing service.

Fabric Preparation

Pre-wash a small sample of the fabric. If you're happy with the result, wash your yardage.

Sizing:

This coat runs fairly normal in size. It is a bit more generous through the shoulders and bust. To make sure you have enough room in the hips, measure the width of the back pattern piece at the hip level and double that figure. That will give you approximate overall width.

Templates:

In the addition to the templates as outlined in the instructions, watch the welt pocket portion of the video to understand how to make a template for the welt.

Layout:

If you are using the woven jacquard fabric from the kit, you do not need to match every motif. Simply think about what motif you would like to have running down the center back and perhaps match that, and think about how to continue a general order of motifs horizontally across the front and continuing around to the back.
