- Metro Skirt digital pattern
- Metro Skirt Kit (optional purchase)

 - 60" 2¼ yards All Sizes
 - 45" 2¾ yards XS-M
 - 45" 31/3 yards L-XXL
- 2-yds ½" Elastic
- ¼-yd Interfacing
- One %" Button (optional)
- 100% cotton thread for sewing woven fabrics
- Isacord thread for overlocking
- Silk thread for marking tailor's tacks and hand sewing needle
- Manilla file folder
- Glasshead silk pins
- Frixion pen
- Chakoner
- 18" C-thru ruler
- Point turner
- Point Presser

You willgresdiats wind machine that has been cleaned and oiled and is in good condition. If your machine also embroiders and has a 9mm throat plate, you may want to invest in a 5mm-wide throat plate. If you have the even feed feature on your machine, engage it. If not, add a walking foot, if possible. We recommend a serger for seam finishes.

Purchase the Pattern

Purchase the digital Metro Skirt pattern. You can now select for us to print the pattern for you from our in-house printing service.

Fabric Preparation

Pre-wash a small sample of the fabric. If you're happy with the result, wash your yardage. Silk noil will soften and increase its texture when washed.

Sizing:

This skirt is a long skirt and can be shortened using the lengthen and shorten lines. It runs true to size in the hips. Be sure to check the length of your elastic by measuring your waist and subtracting 4" which we mention in the video.

Notes:

In the addition the templates as outlined in the instructions, watch the Savvy Sewing Series video on slipstitching if you are not sure how to slipstitch your waistband openings closed.
