MATERIALS LIST

- [Teagarden Tee](#) digital pattern
- [Teagarden Tee Kit](#) (optional purchase)
 - Or use similar fabric
 - 45" & 60" 2½ yards - S-L
 - 45" & 60" 2½ yards - XL
 - 4" x 60" strip of knit in a coordinating color (optional) for bottom band detail
- ½-yd Interfacing
- 100% polyester thread for sewing knit fabrics
- Isacord thread for overlocking
- Pedal pads (optional)
- Various Silk threads for marking tailor's tacks and hand sewing needle
- Strips of tissue paper for darts and body finishing techniques
- Manilla file folder
- Glasshead silk pins
- Frixion pen
- Chakoner
- 18" C-thru ruler
- Fusi-Web
- Ripper
- Seam gauge
- Sleeve board
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Trimming scissors
- Large cutting shears
- Walking foot or engage even feed feature
- Edgestitch Foot
- Tailoring board
- Tailors ham

You will need a sewing machine that has been cleaned and oiled and is in good condition. If your machine also embroiders and has a 9mm throat plate, you may want to invest in a 5mm-wide throat plate. If you have the even feed feature on your machine, engage it. If not, add a walking foot, if possible. We recommend a serger for seam finishes.

Purchase the Pattern

Purchase the digital Teagarden Tee pattern. You can now select for us to print the pattern for you from our in-house printing service.

Fabric Preparation

Pre-wash a small sample of the fabric. If you're happy with the result, wash your yardage.

Sizing:

This tee is generous fit in the top because of the gussets. It can be slim in the waist and hips. You can add at the side seams, front seam and back seam to adjust. This garment is very flattering on women with ample busts as Kathy mentions in the video.

Pressing Templates

Using a manilla file folder, cut the following templates for your hems:

1" x 11"

2" x 11"

Seam Finishes

You can choose how you would like to finish your seams. There's no need to finish your knit seam, so it is okay to leave these seams unfinished.
